



The above is a Draught of a Survey made November 22d 1832, in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to David Hays, Dated Oct. 13th 1832, for 15 Acres of land, Containing thirteen Acres & three perches and Allowance of six per Cent for highways, Situate in Smith Township, Washington County, on the waters of Raccoon Creek. Note the improvement appears to be much older than the time of Interest mentioned in the warrant, but how much I could not find out. the Applicant told me he proved the time he first improved the land, but perhaps it had been improved for 25 or 30 years before that time by others.
