



In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Hindman dated the 6th of Nov. A. D. 1829 Surveyed the above described tract of Land on the 5th day of Janr. 1830 containing four hundred acres, ninety-two perches and the allowance of six P. Ct. &c. situate in Sugar creek township Armstrong county bounded by other lands of Thomas Hindman, lands surveyed to Manasseh Coyle, lands of Manasseh M. Faddon and other lands as represented by the preceding Draught.
