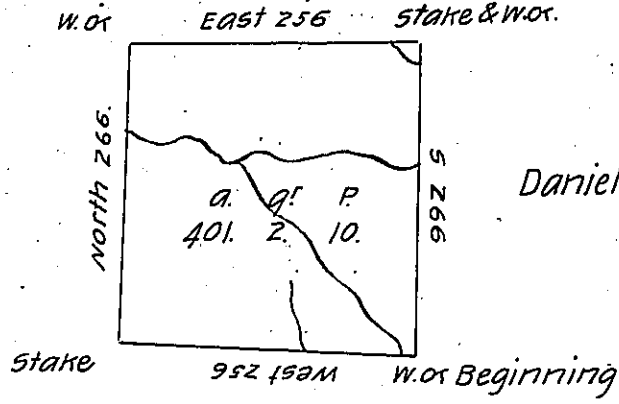

The above is a draught of a survey made the 12th of February 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Hunter for 400<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> acres & ~~10 poles~~ of land Dated the 14th of April 1792 situate North and West of the River Ohio on the waters of big Bever Creek adjoining land granted to Henry Knox called Mulbery containing four Hundred <sup>one</sup> and acres a half and ten poles Together with the usual allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads.
