



"In pursuance of an actual resident settlement and improvement of John Hodges the annexed described tract of land containing 351 acres 35 ps and allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c. was surveyed for him the said John Hodges on the 13th day of November A.D. 1828, and it appeared that there was upwards of 20 ac. cleared fenced &c. on the same. Situate in Venango township Crawford county Pa. James Herrington"
