



The above is a Draught of a Survey made April the 3^d 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to James ^{Johnson} ~~Miller~~ for 400 Acres of Land Dated the tenth day of February 1794 Adjoining John Wilkins Jr. on the South West Side West of the Venango Path and including a Stream that empties into the Ohio North and West of the River Ohio Allegheny and Gonawango Creek on the Waters of Lawries Run Called the Mud Lick place Containing four hundred thirty Eight and an Half Acres and Sixteen poles together with the usual allowance of Six P: Cent for Roads
