



In Pursuance of a warrant granted to James Irwin bearing Date the eighth day of Aprile 1788. Surveyed on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of November 1811. unto the aforesaid James Irwin the above described tract of land Containing fifty six acres & eighty nine and one fifth perches and allowance proportioned at six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent adjoining lands of Benjamin Lord now Andrew Birely Esq. William Thomson now Samuel Thomson & the Rev<sup>d</sup> William Swan <sup>Situate</sup> on Braddocks road in North Huntingdon township in The County of Westmoreland including his improvement Consisting of about twenty acres of land cleared & fenced &c. improvement first Commenced in March 1772.
