



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Ninth day of September 1754 Surveyed unto Jeremiah Hess a tract of land Situate in Frederick Township in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup> Beginning at a White Oak a Corner of George Haon's land thence by land of Peter Bernard North East one hundred and fifty perches to a White Oak thence by Vacant Land South East one hundred and thirteen perches to a post thence by Vacant land South West one hundred & fifty perches to a post in a line of Christian Getzen degners land thence by the same North West twenty perches and by land of George Haon the same Course Ninety three perches to the place of Beginning containing one hundred acres with the usual Allowance of six Percent -  
 Surveyed Novem<sup>r</sup> 7<sup>th</sup> 1754 By Nich<sup>s</sup> Scull
