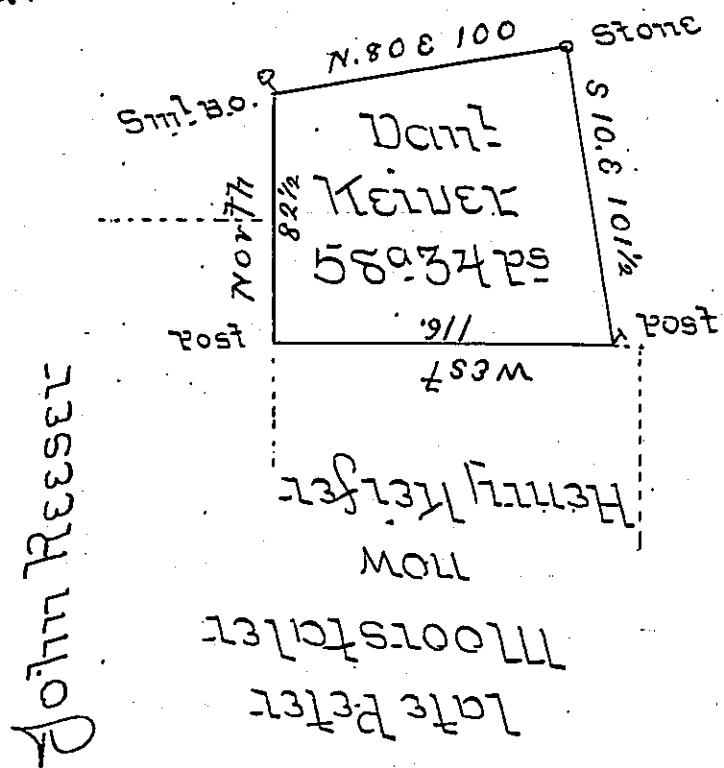


Francis Michael Bishop



By virtue of a Warrant dated the 15<sup>th</sup> January 1745/6  
 Surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> August 1749 to Daniel Keiver  
 the above described tract of land formerly situate  
 in Saucon Township Bucks County (now in Upper  
 Saucon Township Northampton County) contain-  
 ing fifty eight Acres thirty four perches and the  
 allowance of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent & ca taken from a General  
 Draft of James Scull's late Deputy Surveyor the  
 28<sup>th</sup> December 1804
