



By Virtue of a warrant dated the 16th day of March A.D. 1792 there was surveyed the 10th day of November 1793 for Bernard Keplinger (alias Kepner) the above described tract of land situate in Brunswick Township Berks County containing one hundred acres one hundred perches & allowance of six Percent to Samuel Cochran Esq. Henry M Richards U.S. Surveyor General.

Note the above tract including that part contained within the dotted lines A.B.C.D.E.F.G.H. was returned by Henry Wanderslice U.S. and interfered with a draft in the name of Abigail Scull of 50:24. Surveyed on Warrant dated the 12th of June 1751 and is now returned at the Request of Bernard Kepner Junr who possesses both titles, excluding that part laid on Abigail Scull's tract.
