



SITUATE in West Providence township Bedford (formerly Cumberland) County containing 373 acres 96 perches & allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Surveyed for Abraham Ritchey the present owner, the 15th of August 1851, being composed of parts of three tracts, as follows Viz. 1st. containing 270^{ac} 115^{ps} & allowance being part of tract containing 431 acres 71 perches, Surveyed the 29th of October 1766 on warrant granted to William Henry for 300 acres dated the 9th of June 1762, Resurveyed the 29th of April 1802, in pursuance of an order granted by the Board of Property dated the 1st of April 1802, 2nd. containing 63^{ac} 27^{ps} being part of a tract containing 420 ac 86 ps Surveyed on Warrant granted in the name of Edward Gibbons dated the 18th of March 1794, and the 3rd containing 39^{ac} 123^{ps} being part of a tract containing 397 ac 100 ps Surveyed on a Warrant granted in the name of John Beams dated the 18th of March 1794, Returned for Abraham Ritchey, for patenting the 9th of September 1851.
