In Pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Catharine Cheshire bearing date the 23<sup>d</sup> day of August A.D. 1749 Resurveyed by the old lines and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1811. for and at the request of the owner James Patterson who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation.
