



SITUATE in Paradise Township in the County of York containing as above set forth fifty four acres & allowance, Being part of a larger Tract of 259^{ac} & 133^p & allowance, which was originally Surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. in May 1768, In pursuance of a Warrant for 250^{ac} Granted to Hance Hamilton bearing date the 14th day of June 1763. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 26th day of July Anno Domini 1809 for George Yohe the present owner who desired me to make Return of the Draught.
