



SITUATE in Paradise Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 26<sup>ac</sup> & 133 perches and allowance - Originally Surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. in May A.D. 1768 & pursuant of a Warrant for 250<sup>ac</sup> granted to Hance Hamilton bearing date the 14<sup>th</sup> day of June 1763. Resurveyed nearly by the old lines in pursuance of the afore-said Warrant the 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> days of July A.D. 1809.
