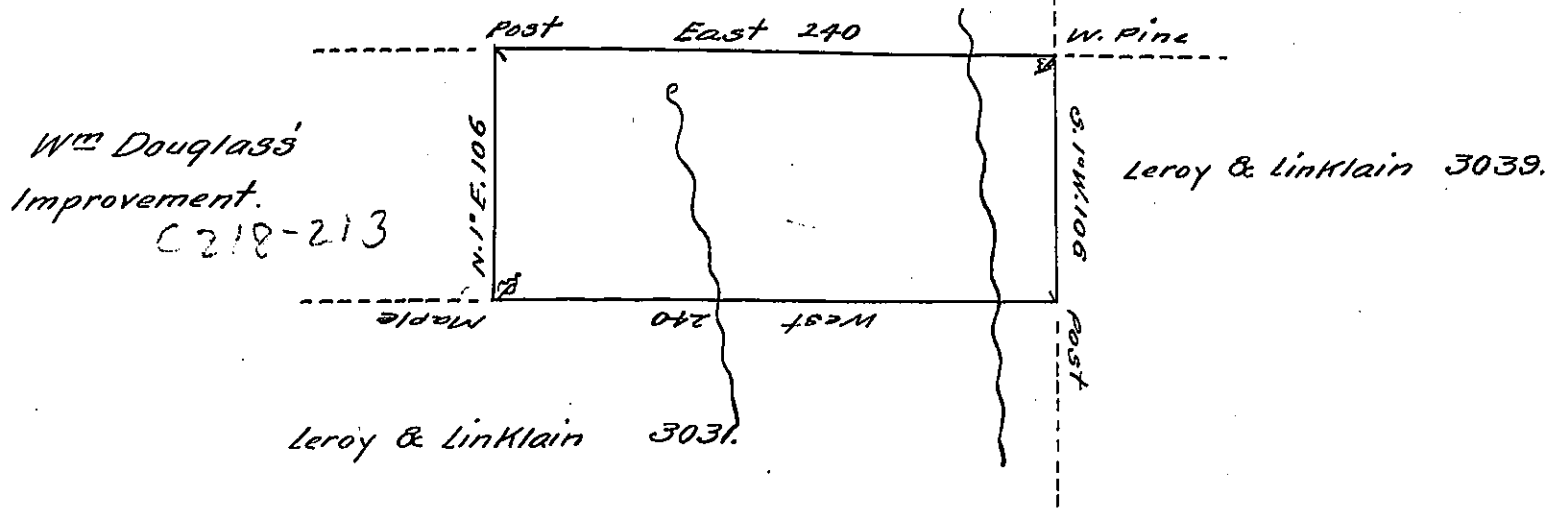

By virtue of a Warrant granted to Elijah Heath for 150 acres; dated at Harrisburg, the 8th day of July A. D. 1846.
