Surveyed April 27<sup>th</sup> 1808 for Samuel Hughes Esq<sup>r</sup> in pursuance of a Warrant <sup>granted</sup> to Jacob Hiltzeimer Dated September 6<sup>th</sup> 1792 by Joseph Snively Jun<sup>r</sup> Ass<sup>t</sup> surveyor for Thomas Kirby Esq<sup>r</sup> late Dept<sup>t</sup> surveyor, as appears by an official Draught thereof remaining in my office.
