Surveyed November 16<sup>th</sup> 1808 for Samuel Hughes Esq<sup>r</sup> in pursuance of a Warrant granted John Finley dated September 6<sup>th</sup> 1792 by Joseph Snively Jun<sup>r</sup> Assnt<sup>t</sup> of Thomas Kirby Esq<sup>r</sup> late Dep<sup>t</sup> Surveyor as appears by an official Draught thereof remaining in my office.
