



A Draught of a piece of Land, Situate in Lower Windsor Township in the County of York, containing as above set forth 20<sup>ac</sup> 20<sup>pr</sup>s & allowances part of 255<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub><sup>ac</sup>s & all<sup>e</sup> which was originally surveyed on 20<sup>th</sup> of 6<sup>th</sup> mo. 1788 in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of February 1787 granted to Robert Stuart, and since in part resurveyed by John Becker. And now on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of August 1864 being requested by the present owner George Frey, to make return of the same for Patenting &c.
