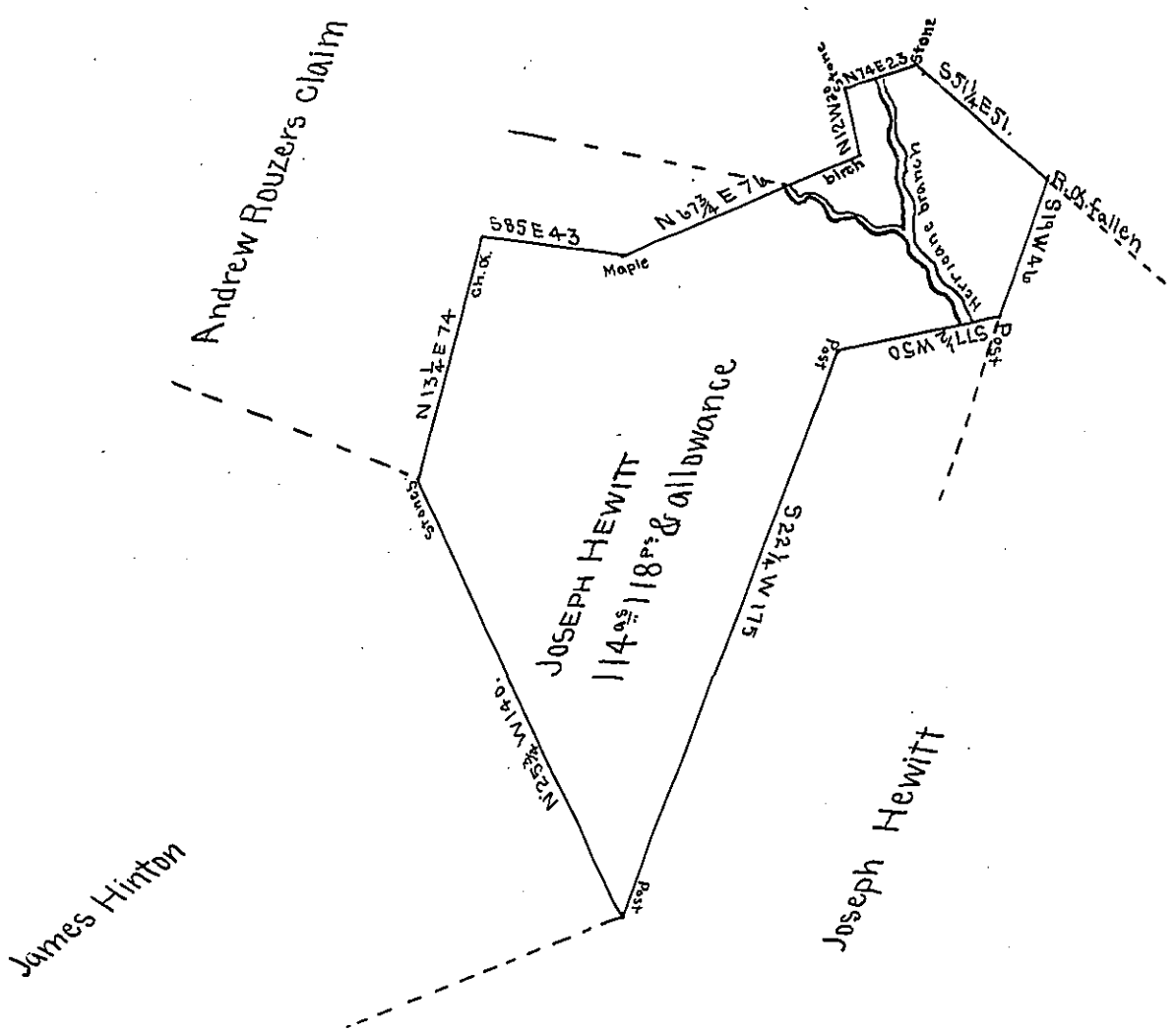


John Nunymaker
