


SCALE - 40 perches to an inch.

A Draught of 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ 53 perches of land, with allowance of 6 per Cent for Roads &c.
Situate in Bratton Township Mifflin County, surveyed in part Nov. 24th & finished
December 16th 1863 in pursuance of a Warrant to David Harshbarger for 8 $\frac{1}{2}$
dated August 26th 1863. About 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ cleared and cultivated for a long time. A few
apple trees on it which look to be forty years old or more.
