



Draft of eighty nine acres and seventy one perches of land with six per cent for roads situate in Millford township in Mifflin county surveyed 5th January 1814 in pursuance of a warrant to W^m Bucannen dated 24th November 1813. Note there are two houses on the above represented land (one partly built by William Irwin and the other by the Warranteer) and some land cleared and in cultivation. Note - further, that part West of the doted line on the above draft was cut off a survey made on a warrant to Jonathan Kearsley dated 4th Feby 1773 by the peremptory orders of William Bucannen the owner thereof, for the purpose of taking advantage of an improvement made by William Irwin on vacant land adjoining - so common fame says.
