



Situate in Carroll, formerly Monaghan township, York County containing as above set forth 52^{as} & 149 perches and the usual allowance, Being part of 213^{as} & 80 perches, Originally Surveyed by George Stephenson D.S. on the 16th day of April 1755, in pursuance of a Warrant for 75^{as} granted to Hugh Hale, dated the 4th day of April 1754, calculated and returned for confirmation by Jacob Spangler D.S. March 3, 1817. Now that part thereof embraced within the yellow shaded lines surveyed and divided off and at the request of Jacob & Aaron Firestone, Christian Bowman and Jacob Heikes, the present owners the same is returned for confirmation, August 12, 1867
