



A draught of Georgia Island situate in the Susquehanna River West Hempfield Township Lancaster County about 3 or 400 yards from the Eastern shore of the river and the most Easterly Island in the range of the Islands at that point, unimproved and containing forty perches & two tenths Strict Measure. (Surveyed the 19th April 1838 by Tho^s Lloyd authorized by Jacob Hibshman Deputy Surveyor) And by Warrant dated the 26th of May 1838 granted to George Horn
