Note, On running the lines of the above survey, I found all the lines marked on the ground said to be done by Fredrick Evans then the deputy surveyor in the year 1794 it appears by the above survey that there is an overplush of ten acres one hundred and thirty two perches more than my instructions would warrant me to return but the owners insists that the whole vacancy be returned as the are willing to pay the purchase money and interest for the access or overplush - If the above cannot be accepted you will please to return this draught to me and I will run off the overplush where the owners may direct
