



By Virtue of a warrant from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries bearing Date the — Day of — Anno Dom — I have Survey'd and Laid unto John Baird in the Township of Hopewell in the County of Lancaster on the west Side Susquehanna River Three hundred and forty nine Acres of Land with allowance of Six P. Gent Beginning at a Locust Thence South Two hundred & Sixty Pches to a Post Thence West Two hundred and twenty Eight Pches to a white Oak Thence North Two hundred and Sixty Pches to a Post Thence East Two hundred and Twenty Eight Pches to the place of Beginning.

Survey'd Nov. 27<sup>th</sup> 1736 P— Zach Butcher Dp. 5.

To Benj. Eastburn Survey<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup>.

1771. October 29<sup>th</sup> Returned for Samuel Kyle by Warr<sup>t</sup> to accept dated the 7<sup>th</sup> April 1769 now in Peters Town P. Cumberland County.
