



A Plan of a Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Reading on the South side of Penn. Street Containing in Breadth East and West Sixty feet and in Length North & South Two hundred and Seventy feet. Bounded Northward by Penn. Street aforesaid Eastward by Lot No 185. Southward by a Twenty feet Alley, and Westward by Lot No 181 marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and Eighty four.

Returned into the Secretary's Office the 21st day of September 1773 for Conrad and Daniel Koch by Warrt dated the 20th Instant.
