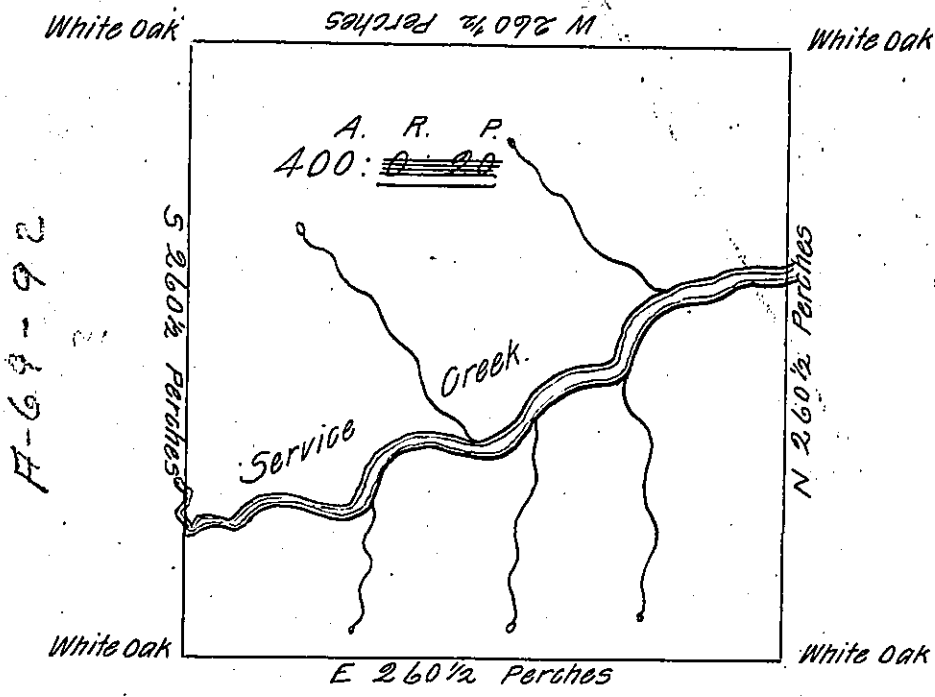

The above is a Draught of a Tract of Land Lying on Service Creek Surveyed for Ulysses Kinsey Decr. 21th 1785 in Pursuance of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia Sept. 16th 1784 Called the Mill-Seat Containing Four hundred Acres ~~and twenty Perches~~ with the Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c.
