



Where as theobald Long obtained Warrant from the Proprietories of Pennsylvania bearing Date the Twenty Eighth of March 1749 (as it appear on the Receipt.) there was Survey unto theobald about thirty five Acres of Land and the Said Theobald Long certain Tract of Land Situate in District Township (then in Philadelphia County now Berks) and the Said Long Sold part there of unto Abraham Danner as above discribed Containing Twenty two acres 10 perches and the allowances of Six P. Cent as it appear by Deed Poll bearing Date 21 Day of August 1777. Where as Abraham Danner sold the Same unto John Koch by Deed Poll bearing Date the 10th day of August 1781 there appear in the deed polls that they Dated the Date of the Warrant Long this 23 of April 1787.
