



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for George Cleaver on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumb^r marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Two Hundred and fifty Six containing in Breadth East and West Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two Hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Southward by Hurtleberry Street, Eastward with Lot Number Two Hundred and fifty five, Northward with Rasperry Alley, and Westward with Center Alley. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 27th day of February 1776 for George Keiser by W^t dated the 23^d of the same Month.
