



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July following on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland, marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Eighty Nine Containing in Breadth on Broad Way fifty Seven feet Six Inches and in Length East and West Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Westward by Broad Way aforesaid, Northward by Raspberry Alley, Eastward by River Alley and Southward by Lot Number Ninety. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 31<sup>st</sup> day of January 1775 for Sebastian Krevass.
