Situate in Washington (formerly) Antrim Township, Franklin County, which was surveyed to Veronica Knepper, the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February 1766, in pursuance of her Warrant, dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August 1765. Resurveyed and divided off the 26<sup>th</sup> day of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1805.
