



The above described tract of Eighty Six acres twenty five perches of Land and allowance, is part of a larger tract of One hundred and sixty seven acres, one hundred and nineteen perches and allowance of Six P Cent for Roads &c Situate in Peters Township Franklin County; which was surveyed to James Knox the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March 1809, in pursuance of his Warrant, dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of December 1773.
