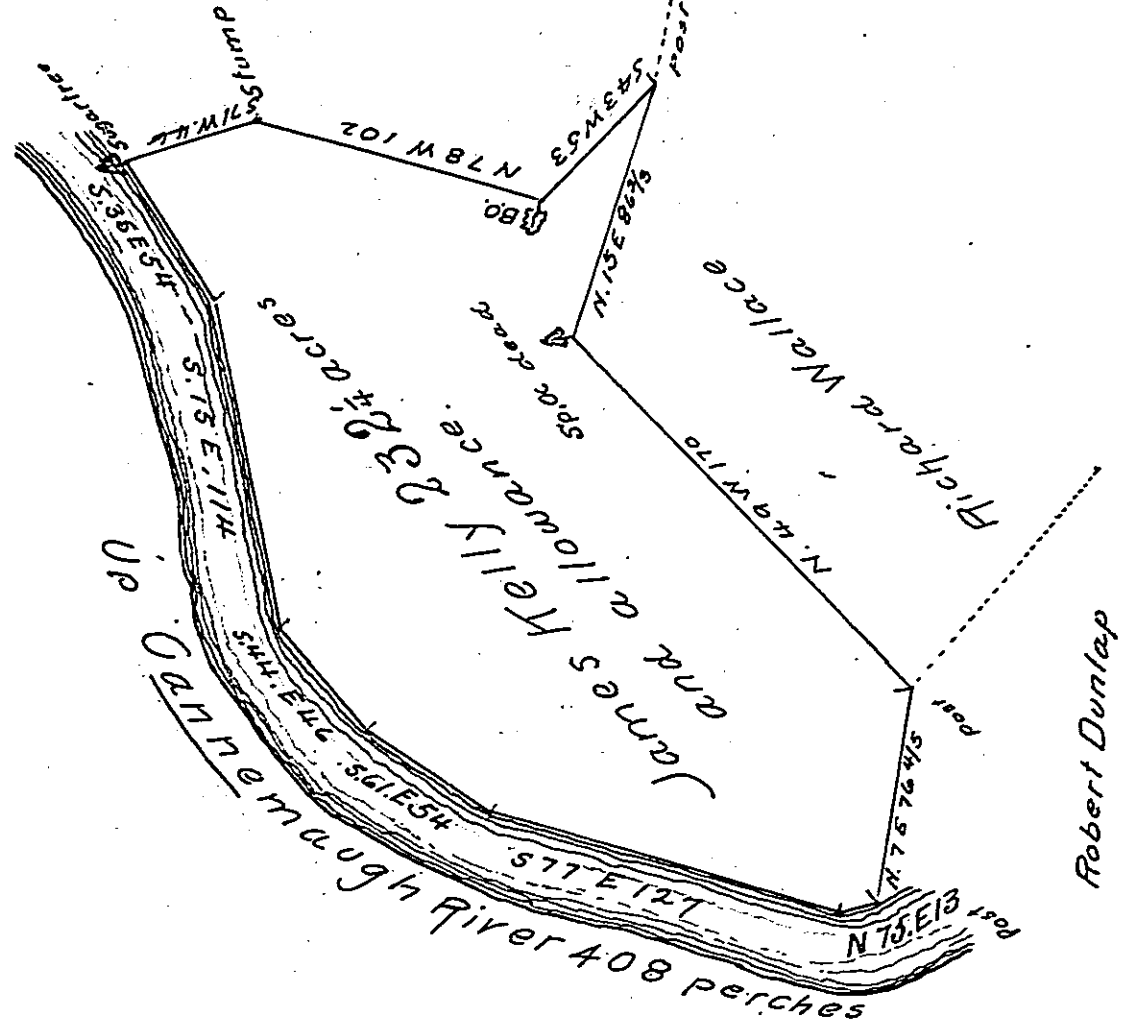


Land in dispute between

In obedience to an order from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Board of Property dated  
March 18<sup>th</sup> 1802 there was surveyed for James Kelly on his Warr-  
ant dated Nov<sup>r</sup> 3<sup>d</sup> 1784 the above described Tract of Land  
Containing two hundred and thirty two acres and one quarter  
of an acre with an allowance of Six p. Cent Situate in Cannaugh  
Township in the County of Westmoreland, Survey'd Ap<sup>l</sup> 28<sup>th</sup>  
1802
