



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1816 containing 159 Acres 144 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. in pursuance of a Warrant granted Henry Johnston bearing date the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February 1790 Situate in Whiteley Township (formerly - Washington now) Greene County on Big Whiteley Creek called "Corpulency" by
