



The above draught is that of the Survey of John Johnston situate in Perry Township Armstrong County and partly in Butler County; which survey appears to have been made in pursuance of a warrant granted to sd. John Johnston dated 31st of Decr. A.D. 1794 bounded by the Allegheny River, lands of Adam Pritz, William Parker and Alexander McDowel.

The above represented Survey of John Johnston is now divided into two parts which division was made 13th of Jan^r A.D. 1827 - The division of Thomas and Mary Ann Graham as represented by the diagram is the actual settlers share agreeable to the Act of 1792 containing one hundred and forty nine acres, thirty four perches and the allowance of six P^r Ct &c. bounded by the Allegheny River and the black continued line of the figure by representation.
