 the Eighth day of January 1734 Surveyed unto Isaac Loyn a  
 Tract of Land Situate in Old Cowissihoppin in the County of  
 Philada Beginning at a Black Oak a Corner of Peter Andreas  
 Land thence by the same North West Eighty Seven perches to  
 a post thence by land of Peter Andreas Switzer & Vacant  
 Land South West ninety Eight perches to a White Oak thence  
 by Vacant Land South East Eighty Seven perches to a post  
 thence by Vacant Land & land laid out to Michael Boots  
 North East Ninety Eight perches to the place of Beginning  
 Containing Fifty acres with the usual allowance of six  
 & Cent Surveyed Jan'y. 20 1734.
