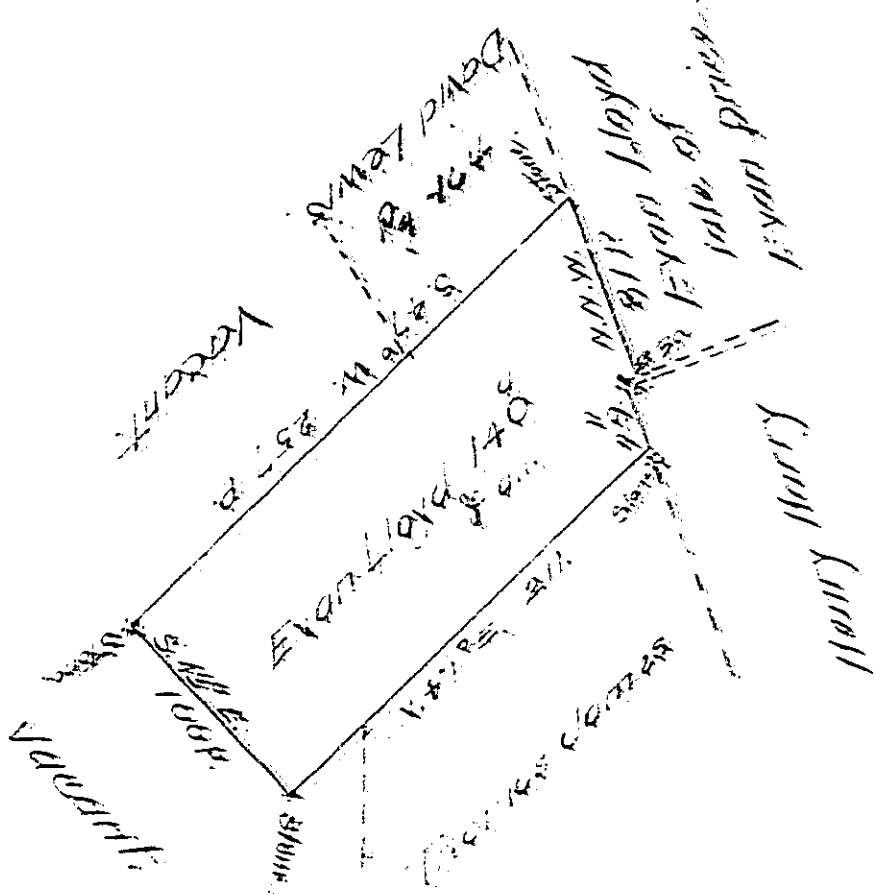

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of 8<sup>th</sup> Mo<sup>o</sup> Anno Dom. 1737

The above Described Tract of Land was Surveyed unto Evan Lloyd in the Township of Cumm in the County of Lancaster Beginning at a Stone Trance South 47 Degrees West by ye Land of David Lewis and Vacant Land 257 perches To a Stone Trance South 43 Degrees East by Vacant Land 100 perches To a Stone Trance North 47 Degrees East by ye Settlement of Thomas James 211 perches To a Stone Trance N. Nor. West by ye Land of Henry Harry 25 perches To a post Trance East North East by the same Land 5 perches To a Black Oak Trance North North West by other Land of Evan Lloyd late of Evan Price 21 perches To ye place of Beginning Containing One Hundred and Forty acres beside ye Allowance of Six<sup>th</sup> Cent For Roads.
