By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Dated the Fourteenth day of February 1733 Surveyed unto Joseph Large a tract of Land Situate in Plumsted Township in the County of Bucks Beginning at a post in the line of his other land thence by the same North West fifty Six perches to a post thence by the same land North East Ninety Eight perches to a post in the line of Matthew Hughes land thence by said Hughes land North West forty four perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South West two hundred & twenty five perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South East one hundred perches to a post in the line of Thos Browns land thence by the same North East one hundred & twenty seven perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred acres with the usual allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent

Surveyed June 5th 1734.
