



The above is a draft of a tract of 425⁹⁵ 24²⁵ of Land situate in Sandy Creek Township on Sandy Creek in Mercer County surveyed the twenty ninth day of June 1824 at the request of Henry Baldwin Esquire of Pittsburg and by the consent of Ross Byars who is the actual settler and has resided thereon for more than twenty years, has a large opening made and two dwelling houses on the tract. Situated and bounded as above described and surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Joseph James the 21st day of April A. D. 1794.
