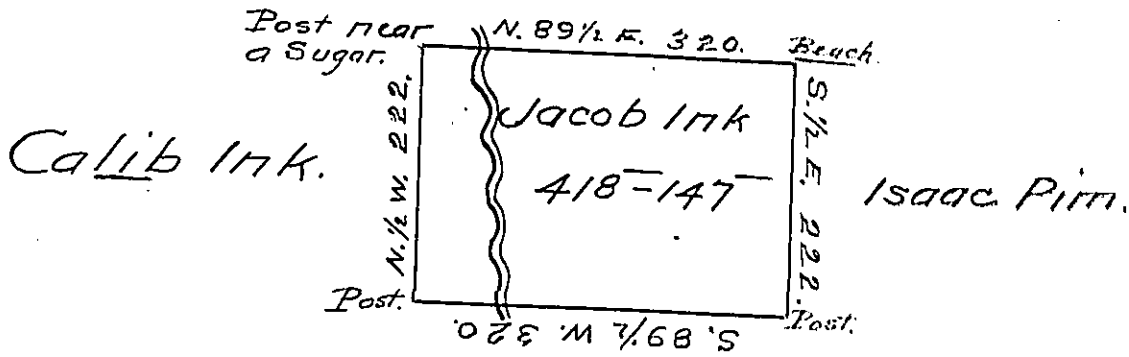

Situate on the waters of the east branch of French Creek in District No. 1 Surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> day of June 1799 in pursuance of a warrant in the name of Jacob Ink. dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April 1793 <sup>and a warrant of the Surveyor Genl (upon an Order of the Board of Property) Dated the 16<sup>th</sup> of May 1799</sup> containing four hundred & eighteen acres & one hundred & forty seven perches and the allowance of six per cent -
