(The Same being part of a tract of land Surveyed the 13th day of June Anno Dom. 1797, $\frac{1}{2}$ Frederic Evans, Esq, late Deputy Surveyor, for Henry Foust in pursuance of his Warrant Dated the 18th day of November A. Dom. 1793:-
