



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia, on the 3<sup>d</sup> Day of May Anno-1753, Granted to Phillip Sheaffer The above description of Land Situate in the forks of Delaware, near the Blue Mountains, in the County of Northampton, and Province of Pennsylvania. Containing One hundred and Eighteen Acres, and 150 perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads, Was Surveyed for the Said Phillip Sheaffer on the 6<sup>t</sup> Day of November Anno-1754.
