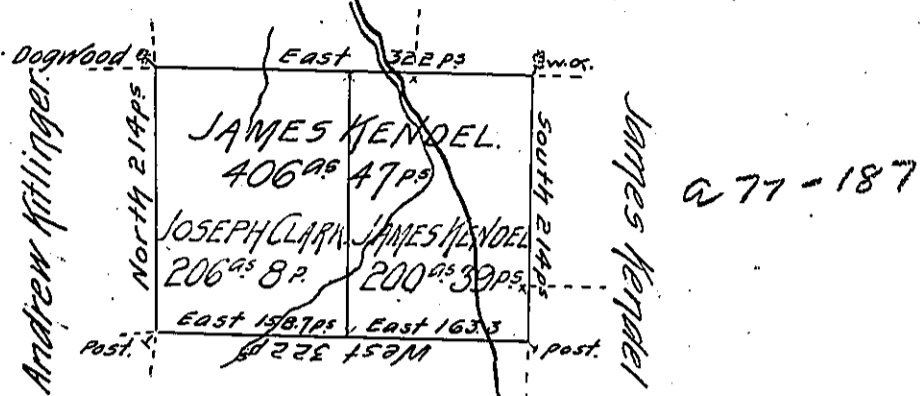

In Pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres, dated the 15th day of July A.D. 1816 was surveyed the 20th Day of August 1816 for James Kendel the above Described tract of Land, Containing four hundred six acres, forty seven perches, and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. and that the same was Divided as stated Between James Kendel & Joseph Clark, of the City of Philadelphia - and at the time of making said survey, the said James Kendel was in possession of the same and there appeared to be about twenty acres Cleared and fenced and a house fit for the habitation of man, and that the same is Situate in Fairfield Township Crawford County Pa.
