 thence by the same South West forty four perches to a post, thence by
 land of Christian Allowbacks North West one hundred and forty three
 perches to a post, Thence by Vacant Land North East one hundred and
 Eighty Three perches to a post, thence by Vacant Land South East one
 hundred and thirteen perches to a Hickry thence by land of Michael
 Fabian South Twenty-five Degrees West one hundred & forty Eight perches
 in the line of ye^{sd} Shippens land thence by the same North West twenty
 perches to ye^{sd} place of Beginning, Containing one hundred and forty nine
 fifty acres with usual Allowance.
