 a Tract of Land Situate in the Township of Salford in the County of
 Philad^a Beginning at a post a Corner of Christopher Harkabrants land
 thence by land of Dericks Johnson south West Seventy three perches to a
 white oak a corner of sd Johnsons land & ye same course by land of
 John Michael Ryker forty perches to a corner white oak thence by land of
 sd John Michael Ryker North West fifty perches to a post and the same
 course by Adam Maurey Seventy perches & by Vacant Land sixty four
 perches to a small Hickrey sapling thence by Vacant Land North East one
 hundred & thirteen perches to a post in the line of Christopher Harkabrants
 land thence by ye same South East one hundred & Eighty four perches to
 ye place of Beginning. Containing one hundred & twenty five perches
 with usual Allowance Nick^o Scull
