of an Order from James Steel to me directed bearing date the 31
of the 1st month 1733. Beginning at a marked Chestnut oak stand-
ing in the Line of a Tract of Land caled the mine tract then
by the said North East one hundred and thirty perches to a
black oak then North West one hundred and thirty perch by
vacant Land to a Hickry marked for a corner then South
West one hundred and thirty perches to a post by vacant
Land then south East one hundred and thirty perch by Law-
rence Person Land to the place of begining. Containing one
hundred and five acrs of Land and 100 perch Situate
lying and being in plumstead Township in Bucks County in Pen-

sylvania surveyed on the 23 of the 3 month 1734. By me.
