



In Pursuance of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 13th day of February 1737, Surveyed to Peter Kerlin on the 10th day of March then next Ensuing, the above described Tract of Land situate in Concord Township in the County of Chester Beginning at a White Oak at a Corner of Joseph Cloud's Land thence North 24° West by the same 71 pches to a post thence South 66° West by the Land Late of Henry Obourn 104 pches to a post thence South 24° East by other Land of the s^d Peter Kerlin 71 pches to a post, thence North 66° East by the Land of the s^d Joseph Cloud 104 pches to the place of Beginning. Containing forty three acres and a half and the usual Allowance for Roads.
