



Surveyed to John Livezey on the 3^d Day of June 1776. The above described Tract of Three Hundred Twenty four Acres & a Quarter of an Acre & Allowance of six p. Ct. situate on a Run emptying into the East side of Plumb Creek about half a mile above the Kittanning Path including a Tomhawks Improvement said to be made by one Kelly in Armstrong Township Westmorland County. By Warrant of the 7th Day of February 1776.
