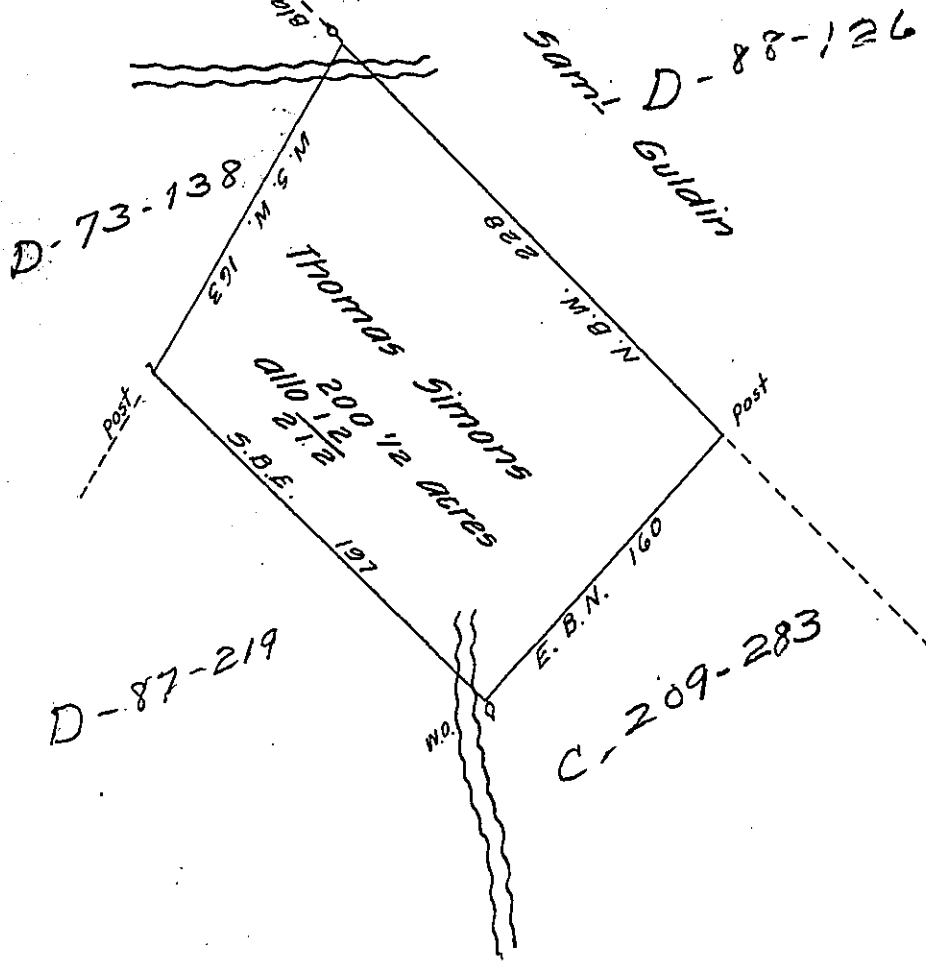

 Bearing Date the 25<sup>th</sup> of the 12<sup>th</sup> month 1716/7 <sup>Feb</sup> I survey'd To Thomas  
 Simmons Two Hundred Acres of Land in the Township of Strasburg in  
 the County of Chester with allowance of six p Ct.

Beginning at a Black Oak standing in the Line of the  
 Land of Saml Guldin thence West south West by a Line of mark-  
 ed Trees one hundred & sixty three pches to a post thence south  
 by East by a Line of marked trees one Hundred ninety-seven  
 pches to a White Oak thence East by North by a Line of mark-  
 ed Trees one Hundred sixty perches to a post thence North by  
 West by the Land of the sd Saml Guldin Two Hundred and  
 twenty Eight perches to the place of Beginning
