Surveyed on the 24th day of December following unto Joseph Irwin the above discribed tract of land situate on the waters of Sewickley—in Hempfield Township in the County of Westmoreland. Containing four hundred and twenty two acres & 97 perches and allowance of six P. Cent for roads &c.

* and another to Henry Herback dated 10th November 1789
