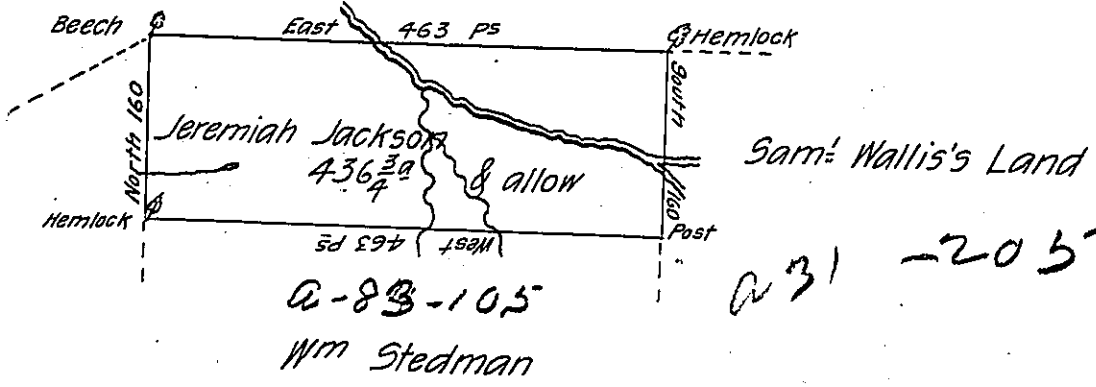


Fred^s Bates's Land
